Last Message from Pastor Walker

June Farewell Vine Article 2025

My Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

I write this, my final Vine article, to you as my farewell. I will retire from the active pastoral ministry on June 30, 2025. I will miss you folks and want to say to you that I love you with the love of Jesus. June 15th will be my last Sunday in the pulpit.

I wish we could have worked better together and were able to move Sandy Mount to the place God is showing me He wants you to be; A place where the lost, weary, broken-hearted, and Spirit will find rest and the peace of God for their souls. (Vision for Sandy Mount). Your mission is to Praise God, grow in love, share the gospel, and touch your community, Sholom Zone, for Jesus' sake. A Shalom Zone is a ministry area that shows God's peace (shalom).

I pray that the whole congregation will come together to move Sandy Mount toward a flourishing and nourishing place of God. It will take all of you on one accord to get back to a full-time Pastor—no more division between Contemporary and Traditional Worship. You can and have had both services co-exist every summer with one service and have done very well. You need to ask yourselves this: Do you think God is pleased with the bickering over worship styles? They can exist together as long as they both glorify and praise the Lord. Chaos is not of God. Fighting amongst yourselves is not of God. Unity, peace, love, and togetherness are needed and exemplify the Lord in your midst.

Jesus said, "If I be lifted up, I'll draw all men unto me." (John 12:32)

To grow numerically, you must grow spiritually. This means Church wide Bible study and prayer. What if Sunday School and Bible study were called "Faith Builders Academy"? This academy would include all ages and stages of Christian growth and development. Yes, this will put strain on you, but it may help to get those on the bench into the game. The academy does not have to be entirely in the church. Some parts of the academy could be housed in the community, in members' homes, modeling the Acts 2 church. It started small in homes in communities and became the mega church of Jesus, the church of today. Inviting friends, co-workers, acquaintances, etc., to a time of study to find themselves and who God says they are is a powerful selling point. It can be done. All things are possible when you move from fear to trust. Fear that you can not help others because you don't have enough. The Psalmist wrote in Psalm 50:10 For every beast of the forest is Mine - the cattle on a thousand hills. In other words, God has what you need. Ask Him for it, and watch the glory of the Lord become alive, manifest in your present reality. You have not because you ask not. I pray that a new season is coming your way, and you recognize it is a season of power and prosperity. Grab hold of it and don't let go until you are blessed. Like Jacob, who recognized He had hold of an angel of God and told him, "I won't let go until you bless me. Jacob held on and received his blessing with his hip out of socket—his reminder about wrestling with God. When you wrestle with God for a blessing, you will get the blessing, and you will remember and be reminded of the result of wrestling with

Sandy Mount, I love you more than you will ever know! Wrestle with God. This is your season to ask and receive, knock, and the door will be opened to you, seek, and you will find.

Live long, love strong, and multiply for the Lord! Yours in His service.
